

Betrayal

To be unfaithful or disloyal; to turn against someone for your own gain

The Historical Resurrection

Early on Sunday morning, as the new day was dawning, Mary Magdalene and the other Mary went out to visit the tomb. Suddenly there was a great earthquake! For an angel of the Lord came down from heaven, rolled aside the stone, and sat on it. His face shone like lightening, and his clothing was as white as snow. The guards shook with fear when they saw him, and they fell into a dead faint.

Then the angel spoke to the women. "Don't be afraid!" he said. "I know you are looking for Jesus, who was crucified. He isn't here! He is risen from the dead, just as he said would happen. Come, see where his body was lying. And now, go quickly and tell his disciples that he has risen from the dead, and he is going ahead of you to Galilee."

Are we to blindly believe in Christ's resurrection without any proof that it actually happened?



Flavius Josephus

(A.D. 37-100)

A Jewish-Roman historian who became a Pharisee and military commander in the Jewish resistance against Rome and witnessed the destruction of Jerusalem in A.D. 70

Josephus wrote in Antiquities 18:63

At this time there was a wise man called Jesus, and his conduct was good, and he was known to be virtuous. Many people among the Jews and the other nations became his disciples. Pilate condemned him to be crucified and to die. But those who had become his disciples did not abandon his discipleship.

Josephus wrote in Antiquities 18:63

They reported that he had appeared to them three days after his crucifixion and that he was alive. Accordingly, he was perhaps the Messiah, concerning whom the prophets have reported wonders. And the tribe of the Christians, so named after him, has not disappeared to this day.



Most scholars believe in both the authenticity and credibility of Josephus' 1st Century writings.

But let's say you don't believe what Josephus wrote and want further proof that the resurrection is true.



The best proof that the resurrection of Jesus actually occurred are the testimonies of those who have been touched by His life-changing, resurrection power



The even better evidence of the existence of Christ's resurrection power is the testimony of someone who has been able to overcome terrible circumstances and rebound to live a blessed life


