She said some of her muscles relaxed but she still had pain in her neck. I remembered the story of Jesus praying over a man who couldn't see. Initially he saw men that looked like trees but after the second prayer, his eyes were healed. So I asked her if we could pray a second time. When I prayed the second time, I heard the word anxiety. She seemed unsure but we decided to continue to pray and just try anyway. I asked her to make her hands like a bowl and just place anything she may think causing her anxiety at the feet of Jesus. A few days later, Pastor Yvette informed me that God healed Kekualani's pain and ear. All praise and glory to God!

I believed God wanted to use Kekualani's testimony of healing to increase faith and to heal other people experiencing ear problems. As Matthew 10:8 says, *Freely you have received; freely give*. After sharing our testimony on Sunday, I felt led to ask if anyone in the church was also experiencing ear problems, dysfunction of their ears, or wearing a hearing aid. To my surprise and amazement about 8 people came to the front to receive prayer for their ears!
